A Taste of Tuscany in the Park:

A Benefit for The Madison Square Park Conservancy featuring the wines of Marchesi De'Frescobaldi

Please join A Voce Restaurant and Marchesi De'Frescobaldi in a traditional Italian "Aperitivo e Stuzzichini" fundraiser to benefit The Madison Square Park Conservancy on Thursday October 11, 2007 from 6:00pm-8:00pm.

The Frescobaldi, one of Florence's most prominent noble families since the 13th Century, has been at the vanguard of Tuscan winemaking for over 700 years. Three of their wines will be featured, alongside Chef Andrew Carmellini's signature passed Italian appetizers, including:

2000 Brut Millesimato, Marchesi de'Frescobaldi

Made in the classic "Champagne" method using Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, sourced from 40 hectares of vineyards leased by the family in the DOC Trentino Classico.

2006 Collio Sauvignon, Attems

Made from 100% Sauvignon Blanc from 30 year old vines, located in the village of Lucinico, in the heart of Collio, near the Alps, a DOC recognized for white wines of distinct character.

2005 Tenuta di Castiglioni, Marchesi de'Frescobaldi

Made from a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Sangiovese, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, and Petite Verdot, sourced exclusively from estate vineyards and mostly young vines. The 2005 Tenuta di Castiglioni is the third release of the Estate's flagship wine.
